Accommodation/Housing

UoS Accommodation

Guaranteed for full year exchange students*

Recommended that semester students apply as there is usually good availability

Costs (Single semester)

UoS Accommodation ranges from £1,982.90 to £4,005.20

Price includes utility bills, internet, 24hr security, Residence Life

Private Accommodation

SmartMove Sheffield

Lots of affordable private options although may be more expensive than UoS (as not always inclusive of bills etc)

How to apply

- Follow the process set out by your home university and we will contact you directly once you've been nominated, deadline to apply for FY/Autumn 24/25 is 31 May 2024
- Application includes: providing an official and up to date transcript from your home university, a valid English language qualification (ELQ), information on the modules you want to study
- Visas: you may need a Student Visa if you are coming for the full year, more information will be provided during the application process
