






























#### HOUSING OPTIONS AT UVIC



#### ON CAMPUS HOUSING

On-campus housing is not guaranteed, and it is by lottery system. There are options for dormitories (with meal plans) to cluster or pod housing (with no meal plans). The range can be as high as \$1,912 CAD or NT\$44,423/month for a dorm with meal plan to as low as \$1,128 CAD or NT\$26,203/month for cluster/pod housing.


#### **OFF CAMPUS HOUSING**

Renting an apartment, basement suite or condo can range from \$800 CAD or NT\$18,584 to \$2,000 CAD or NT\$46,464/month.









## What is the Dual Degree Program?







# WORKING IN CANADA AFTER GRADUATION

- After graduation, students are eligible to apply for 3 year PGWP (post graduate work permit). This is an open work permit for Canada so you can gain more Canadian work experience.
- If interested, a PGWP could help graduates qualify for permanent residence in Canada.



## REQUIREMENTS

#### 2. English language proficiency requirement:

\*\*NOTE: Only current exam marks (within 2 years before application) are accepted

IELTS: 6.5 with no section less than 6.0

#### <u>OR</u>

■ TOEFL: 90 (iBT) with no band less than 20

Conditional Acceptance is offered to students who have IELTS 6.0 (each section 5.5) or TOEFL 79 (each section 17). During the conditional period, you will have an opportunity to re-submit another test score. If your new test score does not meet the requirement then there is an opportunity to take a 4-week UAP "University Admissions Preparation" course online or in-person at UVic in August to fulfill the UVic English Language Requirement.

## APPLICATION MATERIALS

#### There are 4 parts to the Dual Degree Application:

#### 1. Personal Statement Submission

- This is where you introduce yourself and tell the program who you are and why you want to join the Dual Degree program. You can highlight any work, academic, volunteer and/or life experiences.
- Answer the question "How will your experience help make a positive change in the UVic or Victoria community?"
- Minimum 250 words in paragraph format. Save as a PDF to be uploaded to Application Form.

#### 2. Application Form

- Completed on *Education Planner BC* online platform
- 3. Official Transcripts from your Home University

#### 4. English Proficiency Scores (IELTS/TOEFL)

Have your Test Centre send it directly to UVic

## HOW TO APPLY

#### **APPLICATION DEADLINE: January 31st**

#### 1. Personal Statement and Application Form:

Once you have finished preparing your *Personal Statement Submission*, go to the **Education Planner BC Website** (https://apply.educationplannerbc.ca/) and fill in the Application Form and upload your *Personal Statement Submission PDF*. After submission, please notify our office that you have applied to the Dual Degree program GSBIntlAsctDir@uvic.ca.

#### 2. English Proficiency Score:

Have your English Test Centre send your TOEFL or IELTS exam results directly to UVic. Please send us a copy or screenshot by email to: <a href="mailto:GSBIntlAsctDir@uvic.ca">GSBIntlAsctDir@uvic.ca</a>.

#### 3. Official Transcripts:


