

# GLOBAL CONNECT SCHOLARSHIP

As part of the Enabling Partnership Scheme, The University of Queensland (UQ) is proud to offer all eligible students from National Cheng Kung University (NCKU) the Global Connect Scholarship (GCS) to pursue pathway programs approved by UQ and NCKU.

## Scholarship details

A 25 per cent tuition fee reduction is available for eligible students from National Cheng Kung University who commence an approved pathway program at The University of Queensland for the duration of their studies.

Successful scholarship recipients will also receive a dedicated welcome session and networking sessions each semester, in addition to opportunities to engage in UQ's flagship entrepreneurship programs through UQ Ventures.

## Eligibility

To be eligible, National Cheng Kung University students must:

- meet UQ program entry requirements
- agree to the Scholarship terms and conditions
- commence studies in UQ's Faculty of Business, Economics and Law via an approved credit transfer pathway
- not hold any other UQ scholarship.
