
The City of Lancaster is set between Morecambe Bay and the picturesque Pendle Hills (right).



Entry requirements



Academic

Upper second class honours degree or equivalent in specified disciplines

English Language proficiency:

- IELTS 7.0 (with at least 6.0 in each element)
- iBTOEFL 94 (19 reading, 19 listening, 19 speaking, 22 writing)
- Pearson Test of English (academic) 65 with at least 50 in each element
- Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE) grade C or above
