The ancient capital of Taiwan, is situated on the southwestern coastal plains of the island and enjoys a warm climate year-round. Why TAIWAN?

LANGUAGE

The Chinese language is prestigiously recognized as one of the oldest written languages of the world. Chinese is a critical language of trade if students opt to professionally integrate into the Asian market.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship offerings for international students are in abundance. The Taiwan government offers various scholarships such as ICDF, MOFA or MOE. These scholarships cover all educational expenses and provide a substantial monthly stipend.

Students can also apply directly to the universities for scholarships. Most Taiwan universities offer a tuition waiver and a small monthly stipend.

SOCIETY & CULTURE

Upon entering Taiwan, one may be awed of the beautifully designed temples and ceremonial structures. This fascinating island is abundant in culture. The genesis of Taiwan is fervently stenciled in the fabric of modern society. This is displayed in their tea-drinking culture, various artifacts and temples and through various ancient holiday celebrations such as Chinese New Years, the Dragon Boat Festival and the Lantern Festival.





The National Cheng-Kung University is comprised of eleven (11) campuses, located in the heart of Tainan City. It is among the nation's leading pioneers in academic research. In 2005, NCKU was recognized by the Ministry of Education a global "top tier" university. Since then, the university has expanded into various colleges that strive to maintain that repertoire of academic excellence.

NCKU's College of Management (COM) was originally established in 1956 as the College of Business and later renamed in 1980. It is located at Kuang-Fu campus.

Our college has excelled in the academic arena and has significantly enhanced the university's scholastic prowess. In 2001, COM was regarded by the MOE as Taiwan's best business school. Our College became AACSB accredited in 2011. It consists of 5 departments and 7 institutes, offering 5 bachelor programs, 20 master's programs and 10 Ph.D. programs.

The organizational substructure is comprised of an Office of International Affairs that facilitates international dual-degree and exchange programs, a Case-study Center that promotes industry-university career cooperative programs and teaching with case studies and an APMR Editorial Office.

2. Students are responsible for the health insurance, accommodation costs, and living expenses during his or her duration of study in NCKU after acceptance.

Dual Degree

NCKU's College of Management offers the opportunity to pursue two professional degrees simultaneously. Generally, each student is required to spend one (1) year at their home and host institutions respectively. Students will be awarded both degrees upon successful completion of all approved courses.

INSTITUTE OF INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS

- Complete required application procedure.
- Submit a copy of their Bachelor degree.
- Complete 3 prerequisite courses (9 credits): Statistics, Accounting, and Economics.
- Attend classes for at 2 two semesters and obtain 42 credits (not including the thesis and prerequisite courses).
- Students can apply for credits waiver, up to 21 compulsory credits.
- Write a Master thesis in the host university.

INSTITUTE OF INTERNATIONAL MANAGEMENT

- Complete required application procedure.
- Submit a copy of their Bachelor degree.
- Complete 3 prerequisite courses (9 credits): Statistical Methods, Managerial Accounting, and Managerial Economics.
- Attend classes for at 2 two semesters and obtain 39 credits (not including the thesis and prerequisite courses).
- Students can apply for credits waiver, up to 19 compulsory credits.
- Write a Master thesis in the host university.
