- Overall GPA equivalent to 4.5 on a UQ 7-point scale (4 is a pass) (67/100, 60=pass, 100 is a full mark) of the Bachelor degree
- Have successfully completed one (1) year of the relevant Master study at NCKU College of Management

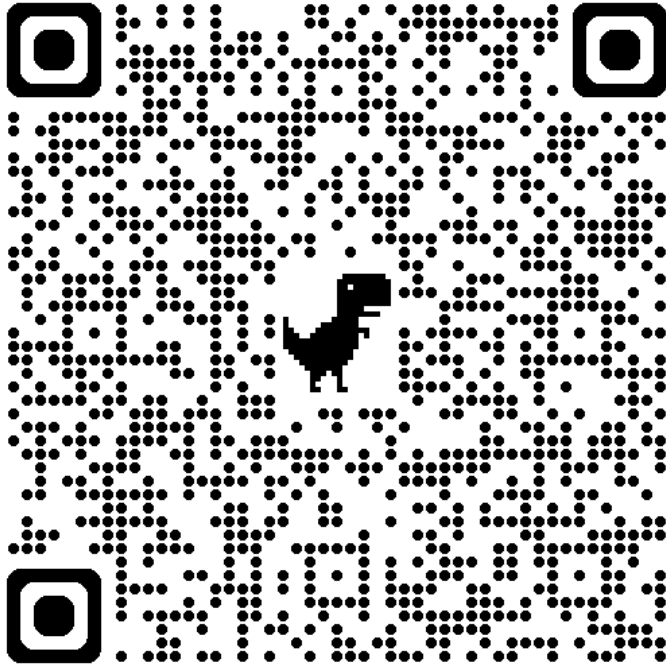
English Language Proficiency requirements

- Medium of Instruction (MOI) fully taught and assessed in English in NCKU English Taught Program can be considered to meet the English entry requirement for the UQ program (UQ's English Language Proficiency Admission Procedure (<https://policies.uq.edu.au/document/view-current.php?id=231>)). OR
- IELTS: overall 6.5 (6.0 in all sub-bands) or TOEFL iBT: overall score 87, Writing score of 21 & Reading, Speaking and Listening scores of 19)

 - Master's program transcript (at least one semester)
 - Enrolment record or Letter of Enrolment of all courses including most recently enrolled in current semester
- **Evidence you have met English language requirements**
 - Certified Medium of Instruction (MOI) Letter signed by NCKU Registrar OR
 - Copy of the IELTS/TOEFL Test Result

Closing dates

- Semester 1 (Feb): End of September of the previous year
- Semester 2 (July): End of February of the same year

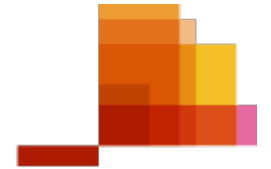

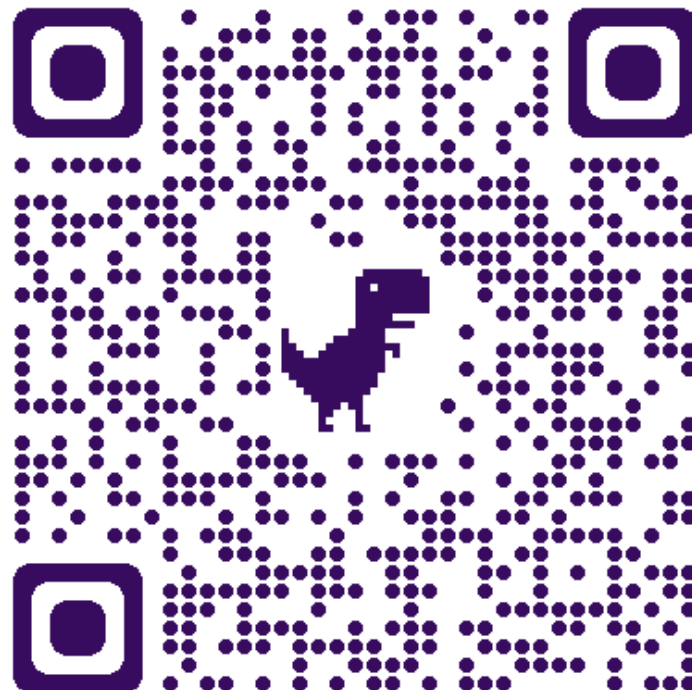

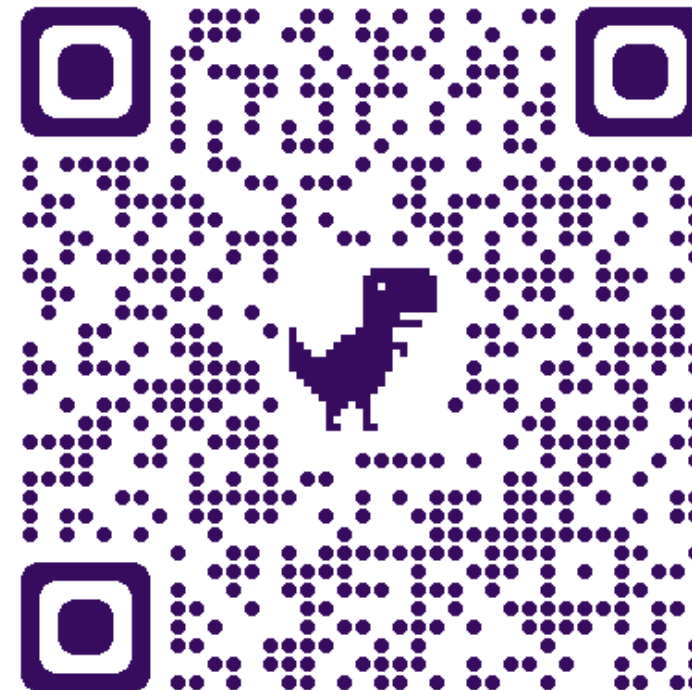
