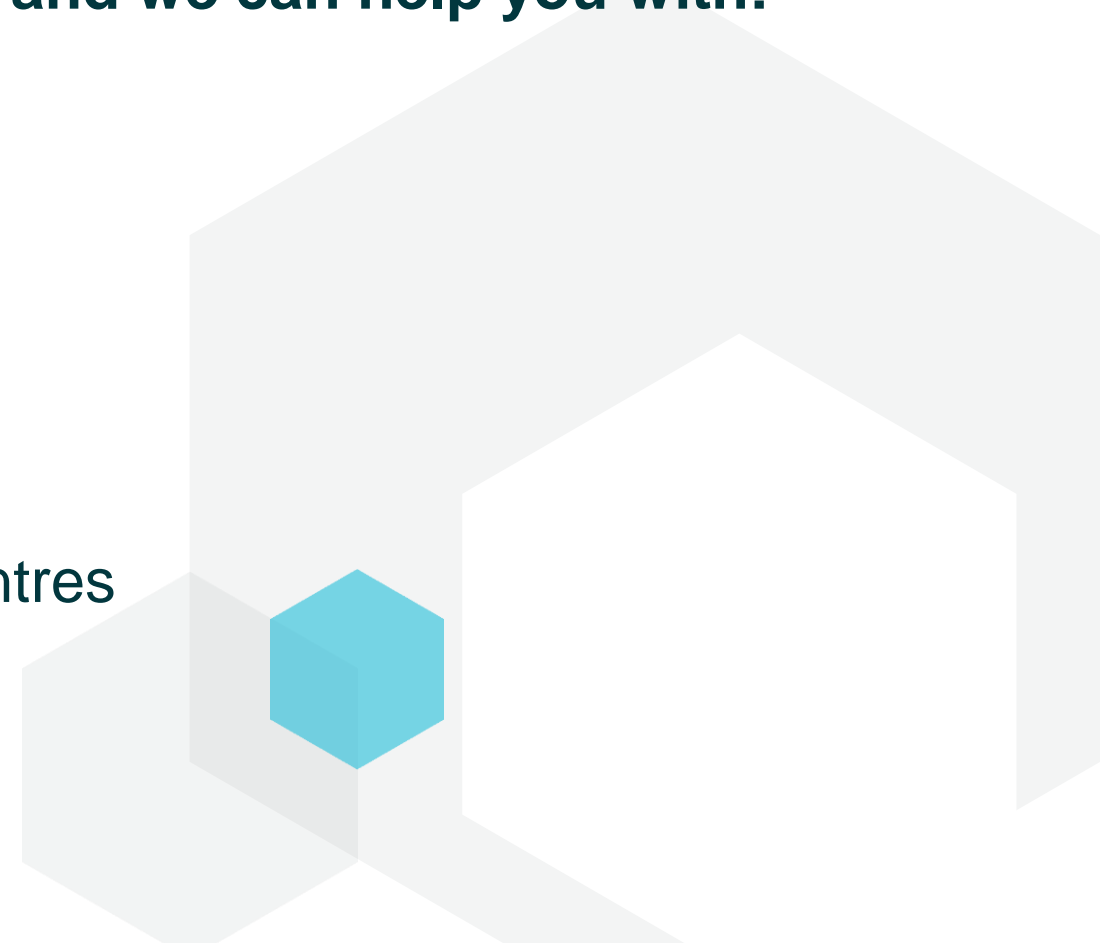
Employability Hub
